

Medical Data

Overview

The medical data screens within the **B-5** sub-menu are designed to completely document any medical issues concerning clients and track updates and/or changes in the medical profile and necessary prescribed medications.

Premium options are also available, which provide utilities for printing prescriptions, maintaining online blood work and injection data and generating tickler type reports on the same.

This chapter describes each regular and elective feature under the following headings.

- **Medical Data** – General and diagnostic medical profile information.
- **Medications** – Current and historical prescription information with progress note interaction and optional prescription printing.
- **Reports** – Selected views of all of the data above.
- **Premium Options** – Blood Work, Injections, printing prescriptions and selected reports.

Client Medical Data

All of the medical data relevant to each client's medical status is entered and stored through the corresponding medical data options. Option **MC** is the interactive data entry screen, whereas **MS** is a view only or show option.

Entering and Updating Medical Data

MC utilizes a combination of data screens and memo boxes to capture the general and diagnostic medical information for each client. In **MC** at the '**Client:**' prompt, enter a specific client number or press <hlp> and enter a client name. The medical data screen for that specific client is then presented.

Viewing Medical Data

The **MS** option allows the user to view only this same data.

Printing Medical Data

Under the Reports heading, option **MP** will print a hard copy report of this medical profile for the client paper record. This feature is described in detail in the Reports section of this chapter.

Medications

All of the medication information relevant to each client's medical and clinical status is entered and stored through the corresponding medication options. **B-5 RC** is the interactive screen in which medication information is entered and subsequently updated, whereas **RS** is a view only or show option.

Entering and Updating Prescription Medications

The **RC** option provides maximum utility for managing and documenting prescription medication and medication management. Prescriptions can be added, edited, displayed, stopped and documented in a progress note from the **RC** screen.

Upon entering the **RC** option, enter the client number at the '**Client:**' prompt or press **<hlp>** to enter the client name. The screen will be a view of the selected client's current medications and history, along with the options for updating the medication record(s).

- **Display** – Shows the full prescription screen as last updated for the highlighted prescription with dosage, route, frequency, doctor and renewal and stop dates. No changes can be made to the data within this option. The same screen above is displayed.
- **Stop** – Designates and records a stop date for the highlighted medication.

Guide. For the note text, however, a template with the client's current medications and indicators for medical/clinical observations are included.

- **Finished** – Returns the user to the 'Client:' prompt, allowing the user to finish with the current client and enter a new client number or name without exiting the RC screen.

Viewing Medication Information

The RS option allows the user to view only this same data.

Printing Medication Data

Under the Reports heading, option MR will print a hard copy report of client medication data for a designated range of clients and selection criteria. This feature is described in detail in the Reports section of this chapter.

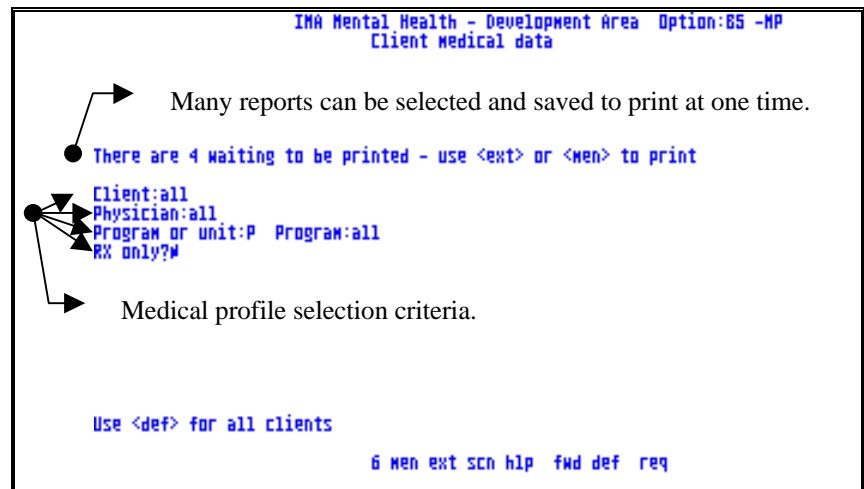
Reports

Each client medical data feature has its own report and selection criteria for a specified, user defined view of that data. The following two reports are standard features. The premium options for Blood work and Injections also have reports associated with that data. Those reports are described in the Premium Options section of this chapter.

Medical Profile Report

Option **MP** offers selection criteria for printing client medical profile data. Reports can be selected according to the following criteria:

- **Client** – A specific client or all clients.
- **Physician** – A specific physician or all physicians.
- **Program or unit:** A specific program or unit or all programs or all units.
- **Rx only?** – Prescriptions only (**Y**) or the full medical profile (**N**).



The selection screen for the medical profile at B-5 MP.

This report lists the complete summary medication information and medical profile data per client. This report can be signed and dated by the physician as a medical profile document for the client paper record. These reports are stored and printed when the user is finished making selections.

Medication Report

Option **MR** offers selection criteria for printing client medication data. Reports can be selected according to the following criteria:

- **Client** – A specific client or all clients.
- **Prescribing physician** – A specific physician or all physicians.
- **Medication** – A specific medication or all medications.
- **Type** – A specific type of medication or all types of medication, as defined in table **MEDTYP**.

- **Include stopped RX?** – Include stopped medications (Y) or include only current medications (N).
- **Start date** – A range of medication start dates from – to.
- **Renewal date** – A range of medication renewal dates from – to.
- **Stop date** – A range of medication stop dates from – to.
- **Sort by** – Client, Physician, Start date or Medication.

This report lists the medications with all of the summary information, including frequency and comment memos. The page breaks on the sort criteria.

Premium Options

The premium options are the features for online blood work and injection management and tracking, reports on that data and printing prescriptions from the Workbench within the Medications option.

- **Medications** – Added features of a blood work requirement reminder screen and printing prescriptions directly from the system.
- **Blood work** – Current and historical blood work information and a report feature on the same.
- **Injections** – Current and historical information on prescribed injections and a report feature on the same.

Additional Medications Features

With the premium option package, the initial screen upon entering the medication data for a specified client at **RC**, is a reminder or alert for the user of the required and routine blood work due for this particular client. This option integrates the blood work information as a prompt within the medication feature.

- To Print a prescription, highlight the desired medication using the up and down arrows or <bck> and <fwd> function keys, type the corresponding code and press <enter>.

This printed prescription will comply with the standard prescription format, including the DEA and license numbers for the prescribing physician, client demographic information and prescription data.

The prescription will print with an attached copy for the client to keep as a record and a copy for the agency paper record. Included on the agency copy is a section for hand written notes by the prescribing physician or designee to document any additional observations and/or concerns. This printout is one page and can be printed on perforated paper or cut and distributed by the agency as appropriate.

Blood Work

All of the blood work information relevant to each client's medical and clinical status is entered and stored through the corresponding blood work options. **B-5 BC** is the interactive screen in which information is entered and subsequently updated, whereas **BS** is a view only or show option.

Entering and Updating Blood Work Data

The **BC** option provides features for managing and documenting blood work requirements and follow-up for medication management. Blood work can be added, edited and displayed from the BC screen.

Upon entering the **BC** option, enter the client number at the '**Client:**' prompt or press <hlp> to enter the client name. The screen will be a view of the selected client's current blood work and history, along with the options for updating the blood work record(s).

- **Display** – Shows the full blood work screen as last updated for the highlighted blood work with type, dates and comments. No changes can be made to the data within this option. The same screen above is displayed.
- **Finished** – Returns the user to the '**Client:**' prompt, allowing the user to finish with the current client and enter a new client number or name without exiting the **BC** screen.

Viewing Blood Work Information

The **BS** option allows the user to view only this same data. No changes can be made in the data within this option.

Printing Blood Work Data

Under the Reports heading, option **BR** will print a hard copy tickler type report of client blood work data for a designated range of clients and selection criteria. This blood work report can be selected for the following:

- **Client** – A specific client or all clients.
- **Prescribing physician** - A specific physician or all prescribing physicians.
- **Program or unit** – A specific program or unit or all programs or all units.
- **Blood work due date** – Range of dates for blood work due.

All of the injection information relevant to each client's medical and clinical status is entered and stored through the corresponding injection options. **B-5 IC** is the interactive screen in which information is entered and subsequently updated, whereas option **IS** is a view only or show option.

Entering and Updating Injection Information

The **IC** option provides features for managing and documenting the administration of injections and follow-up for medication management. Injections can be displayed and recorded from the **IC** screen.

Upon entering the **IC** option, enter the client number at the '**Client:**' prompt or press **<help>** to enter the client name. The screen will be a view of the selected client's prescribed injections, along with the options for updating the injection record(s).

Initial Options

To view the injection history, type the corresponding code and press **<enter>**.

- **Show history** – Allows the user to choose a display of the history of injections for all medications or a selected medication. Each injection can then be selected for a display of detailed information.

Show History Options

- **Display detail** – This screen is the same for each option, either a single injection or all injections, and contains additional information regarding the dosage, location, blood pressure and the full Comments memo box. No changes can be made to the data within this option.
- **Finished** - Allows the user to move onto a different medication within the original screen for the designated client.

For each of these options, highlight an injection using the up and down arrows or <bck> and <fwd> function keys. Then, type the corresponding code and press <enter>.

- **Add** – Add a new injection record. This option also interfaces with the clinical progress notes program to access progress notes from this screen. - **Edit** – Edit any field and/or comments in an existing injection record as seen in previous displays.
- **Display** – Display a highlighted injection record as shown in examples above. No changes can be made to the data within this option.
- **Note** – Add a progress note for documenting injections or for medication management on injections. A template is inserted into the text reflecting the selected injection, current medications and a number of designated observations. This is the same screen that would be accessed through Add an injection note option above. This feature is detailed in the Clinical Chapter of this Guide.

- **Finished** – Returns to the '**Client:**' prompt to continue with injection documentation for another client without exiting the **IC** screen.

Viewing Injection Information

The **IS** option allows the user to view only this same data.

Printing Injection Data

Under the Reports heading, option **IL** will print a hard copy tickler type report of client injection data for a designated range of clients and selection criteria. This injection report can be selected for the following criteria:

- **Client** – A specific client or all clients.
- **Prescribing physician** – A specific prescribing physician or all prescribing physicians.
- **Medication** – A specific medication or all medications.
- **Type** – A specific type of medication or all medication types.
- **Next injection date** – A range of dates for the next injection.
